The mission of Cutie Shell

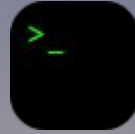
“Cutie Shell aims to be a pretty and easy-to-use mobile UI/UX for Linux devices running either Haliu or mainline Linux. Our UI is inspired by Jolla’s Sailfish OS, but we are not aiming for a clone. One major difference to Sailfish OS is that our source is completely open.”

Overview of the technical side

- Qt6 (We ported from Qt5 in early May)
- qml-module-cutie
 - Provides widgets following the Cuties's visual style
 - Provides API wrappers for applications to interact with the system
- Applications
 - Currently, the Cutie application assortment is: Browser, Messaging (SMS), Music, Phone, Settings, Terminal, Widget Playground
- The base system
 - The development concentrates around Droidian
 - I, personally, use Droidian on the Volla Phone
 - Cutie can be run on other systems; for example, I have tested it on postmarketOS

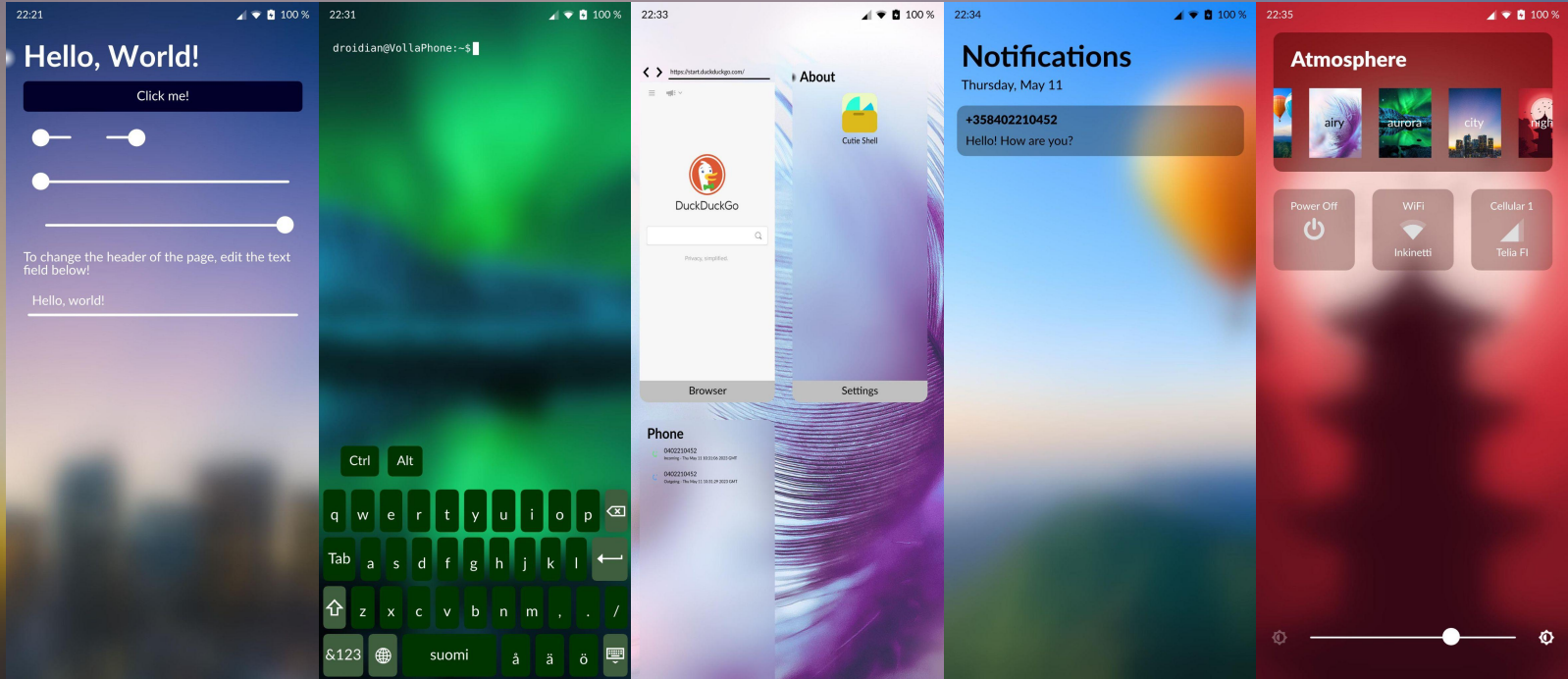
