we are open-source²

I'm doing a (level operating system) just as you know, can be big and professional like gnu) for 386(486) AT clones.? This has been brewing since april, and is starting to get ready.? I'd like any feedback on things people like/dislike in minix, as my OS resembles it somewhat (same physical layout of the file-system (due to practical reasons) among other things).

I've currently ported bash(1.08) and gcc(1.40), and things seem to work. This implies that I'll get something practical within a few months, and I'd like to know what features most people would want.? Any suggestions are welcome, but I won't promise I'll implement them :-)

The idea for **Linux Nordic** was formed in 2019

Linux Nordics founder Robin Haug began observing clear trends in the computing market:

- Increased criticism of the dominant actors
- A growing selection of Linux hardware
- An increased focus on user interaction
- An absence of Linux distributors in Scandinavia

Robin was already a Linux user, and as a philosopher, it became quite clear that his ethical responsibility to commercialize Linux hardware and software.

Robin founded Linux Nordic in 2022 with the express intention to challenge and revolutionize the Nordic IT market.

What is open-source to **Linux Nordic**

Linux Nordic is open-source². This means that we are open in every aspect of our being, from hardware to firmware to software. From access to products to education about transitioning to new systems.

This is safe. This is transparent. This is the future.

New Partnerships

Linux Nordic has entered into a partnership with Denmark's third largest mobile supplier, 3 Mobile, but one of the world's largest service providers, CK Hutchison Holdings.

New Business

Linux Nordic's agreement with 3Business consists of a pilot program to place Volla's mobile phones in all 30 retail shops in Denmark.

This is a new market for Volla, and these amazing products will now be featured on 3.dk's webshop, with both Business and retail subscriptions.

New heights

Sales of Volla mobile phones can reach new heights in the Nordics, but this requires a large sales force.

Approaching January 2024, Linux Nordic will have hired 47 Account Managers, travelling around Norway, Sweden, Poland and Denmark, equipped with a Volla Phones.

In addition, Volla Phones will be seen on buses and trains, in business publications, and during cinema showings.



New sectors

In addition, the plan is to enter the public sector, and get Volla mobile phones into public authorities such as the police and rescue corps, in Denmark and the rest of the Nordic region.



New rules

In addition, Linux Nordic and Volla will collaborate on a school tablet for the Nordic market, as the current Google Chromebooks have recently been banned from use in the Danish school system.

This could mean orders for over 50,000 school children, as well other institutions in Denmark, and that is only a start. Sweden is considering the same solutions.

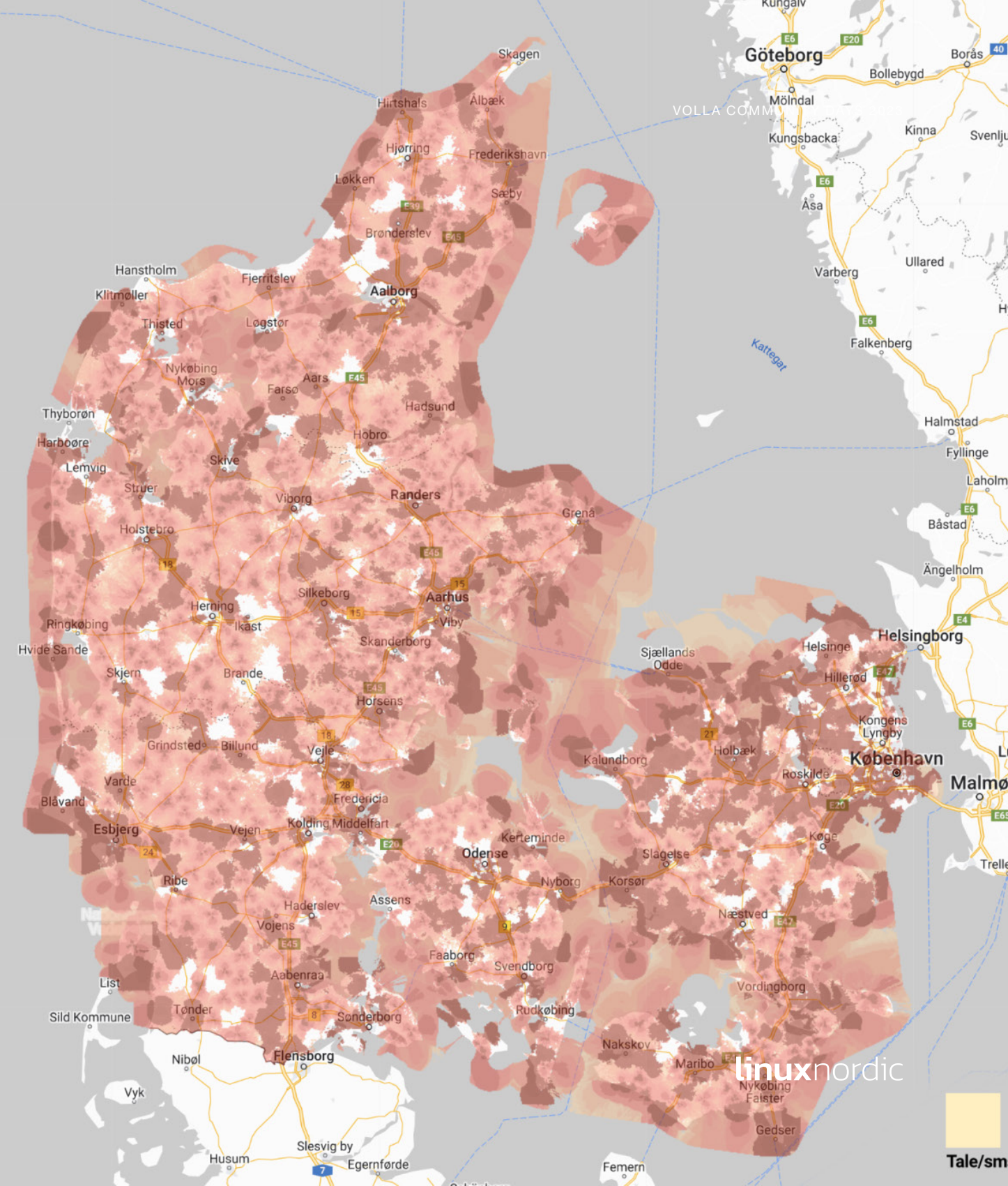
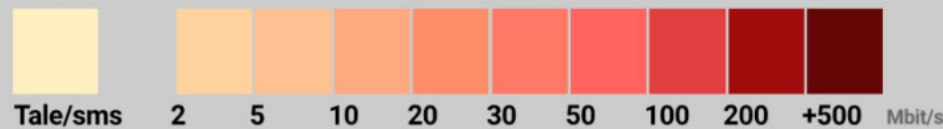
It is therefore precisely now that Linux Nordic is opening branches in Poland and the rest of the Nordic region.



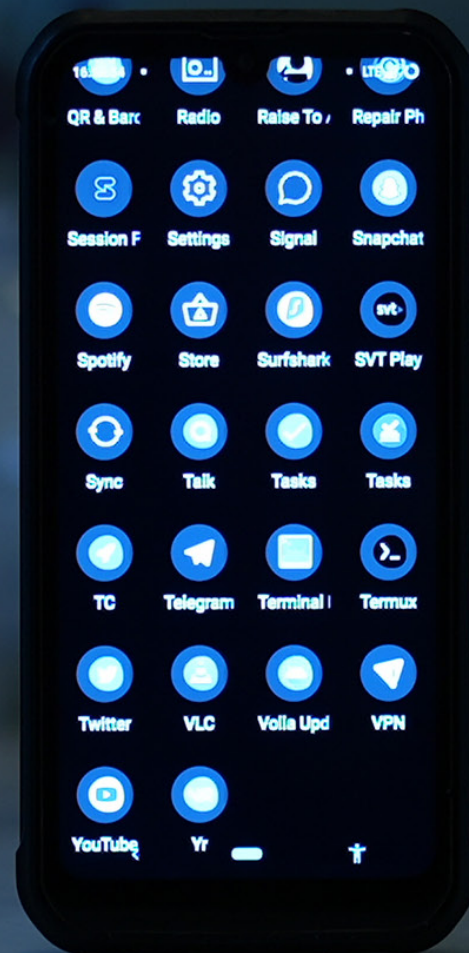
New frequencies

Most mobile phones in Denmark are branded 5G compatible. An optional feature like this could be important for Volla in the future.

Coverage and speed are based on the industry's common calculation model. The expected 5G speed for outdoor use is **25-954 Mbit/s download** and **23-94 Mbit/s upload**.

With Volla mobile phones, Linux Nordic will have the means to infiltrate the monopoly of Apple and Android.

Volla phones are still unknown on the Danish market, but come August we will be running campaigns to spread knowledge and awareness in Denmark, and also in Poland, and soon Sweden and Norway.

Within the next 3 years, Linux Nordic will be operating in 9 different countries.

Our Strategy

- 1 **Grow** awareness of a third alternative
- 2 **Build** relationships with key actors in the public and private sector
- 3 **Use** social media to direct the debate on solutions
- 4 **Introduce** the public to a product they didn't know they needed
- 5 **Encourage** transparency and active participation
- 6 **Exploit** the best features: great hardware + great software
- 7 **Address** the increased demand for Linux OS
- 8 **Educate** and expose the dangers of closed-source
- 9 **Focus** on security (incl. privacy) and economy (right to repair + sustainability)
